### HIPE Coding In Ireland

- In patients and daycases- public hospitals
- Hospital InPatient Enquiry – HIPE
- System managed centrally by Healthcare Pricing Office- HPO
- Approx. 320 HIPE Coders & Managers employed by hospitals
  - 1.8m discharges in 2023
  - Updated to 12<sup>th</sup> edition ICD-10-AM January 2024
- HPO manages national HIPE system – coverage, training, quality, resources for coding, national file, data analytics, ABF.



- Linking HIPE Coders to wider uses of data & data quality issues
- Context for importance of their work at national level and for patients





## HIPE Data Quality Education Sessions

### Quarterly online sessions for all coders

- Scheduled on HIPE training calendar for each quarter.
- 2hr online sessions
- Commenced in 2013
- Informing HIPE community of data quality issues
- Wide range of topics and keeping coders up to date with use of HIPE data across the system
- Cost effective data quality linking directly with HIPE staff.

## HIPE Data Quality Education: Topics

- Link directly to coding community on data quality topics and feedback from HIPE data users
- Feedback at national level on issues identified in audits and data quality reviews
- Training on various data quality tools/running reports.
- Education on coding queries & issues the HIPE Depts have raised
- Teams across the HPO can input or present
- Keep a record of issues for inclusion
- Links in with Coding Notes Newsletter/ coder education.

## Examples of areas covered at DQ Sessions

In 2023 topics covered in the HIPE data quality sessions included:

- Classification updates
- Endoscopy diagnostic coding
- Neonatal sepsis/risk of sepsis
- Overview chart based audits 2022
- Coding of Tobacco Use Disorders
- Augmentation of labour
- COPD/Asthma/Bronchitis
- STEMI and NonSTEMI review
- Clinical documentation

## Education on Challenging Areas

- Include short training sessions on challenging areas
- Wide impact & wide benefit of training
- Identified through audits or data quality reviews
- Complex notes, changing guidelines & rules, difficult to locate codes
  - Clinical language does not match classification language
- High Intensity Training – short and to the point
- Closing data quality cycle
- Examples of topics:
  - Post procedural complications
  - Hospital Acquired Diagnoses
  - COVID-19
  - Endoscopy

# Training in Use of Data Quality Tools

- Ability to include training on use of data Quality Tools
  - HIPE Audit Software
  - HIPE Checker Software
  - Data Entry Edits
  - PICQ tool – reviewing output and responding appropriately
- Practical examples and demonstrations
- Analysis of output or how to report on data
  - Identifying issues locally
- Address issues in data quality checks
  - Understanding why edit or check is firing
- Demonstrate importance of data quality tools



## Data Quality Tools

20,000

### DATA ENTRY EDITS

Edits fire when saving coded case

160

### HIPE CHECKER TOOL

45 hospitals use checker monthly

35

### HIPE CODING AUDIT TOOLKIT

Enables chart based re-abstractation audit and comparison

600

### PICQ

Checks run nightly to measure compliance with coding standards





## What's Happening Out There?

- Human side of HIPE data collection & data quality
- Linking coder's work to data users & patients
- HPO role in responsiveness and development
- Increasing use of HIPE data set
- Increasing audience of stakeholders
- COVID -19 Data
  - Huge effort to collect data with 48 hours of discharge
  - Huge value placed on HIPE Data
- Awareness of upcoming work on data quality and reviews
  - e.g. Sepsis programme audits, anaesthetic audits, Clinical Audits.
