- 1. Get started!
- 2. ...and keep going!
- 3. Importance of people
 - o getting buy-in from all those involved
 - training and support
 - o senior level buy-in and support
 - maintaining corporate knowledge and continuity
- 4. Communication and feedback
 - keep talking and feeding back
 - o don't let data and information go into a black hole!
- 5. Proportionality
 - o keep it simple, no more complicated than it needs to be
 - o don't let the perfect be the enemy of the 'good enough'
 - keep an eye on materiality- focus on getting the big things right
- 6. Finance and incentives
 - financial support to providers helps but depends what other levers available
 - both financial and non-financial incentives rewarding engagement of providers
- 7. Consistency of...
 - Messaging- do what you say you're going to do
 - o reporting requirements- don't chop and change
 - o methods
- 8. Costing data will only be as good as the underlying data so try to build and improve the activity and data from other systems eg. radiology.
- 9. Build the right infrastructure for costing processes and aim for integrated systems
- 10. Openness and transparency
- 11. Data quality- apply some face validity checks: if it doesn't look right it probably isn't
